**WELCOME** to the third of our Scene in Time free family weekenders supported by the Heritage Lottery Fund. This year, we celebrate Wilton's connections with the furthest reaches of the globe. Countless people from around the world have passed through our doors. Wilton's began life around 1690 as a sailors' bar known as the Prince of Denmark, located in what was then a Danish quarter. Since then, the building and its neighbourhood have been home to visitors, traders and communities from all

over the world, including Sweden, Germany, Malta and parts of Asia. enjoy exploring this fascinating aspect of Wilton's history by singing along with sea shanties, making rafts and boats, sewing your own bag to hold aromatic spices from faraway lands, watching and joining in with traditional Indian and Bollywood dance, mixing your own world music track and so very much more!

Wilton's Music Hall is a gem in the heart of London and the oldest grand music hall in the world. This Grade 2 Star listed building is the winner of a RIBA 2016 National Award, RIBA London Award 2016, RIBA London Conservation Award 2016 and is a RIBA London Building of The Year 2016. Wilton's presents a year-round programme of exceptional live music and world-class, adventurous theatre productions alongside a packed community, heritage, learning and participation programme.

**WHAT IS A MUSIC HALL PERFORMANCE?**

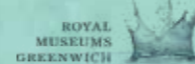

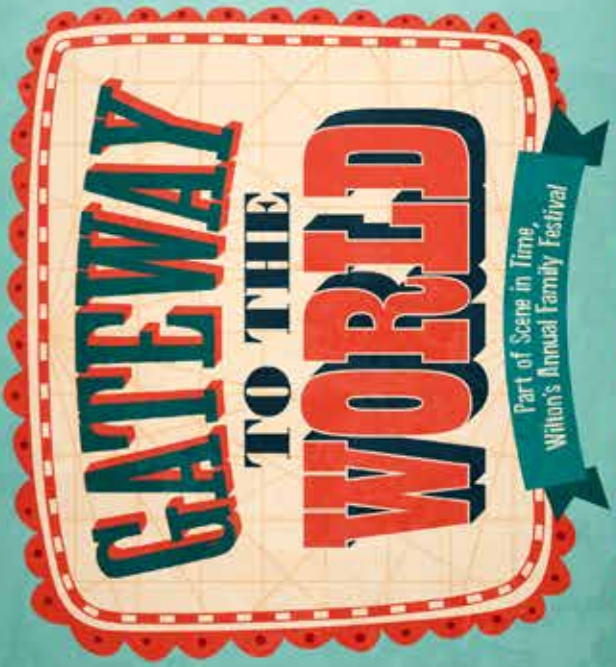

## 4 COME ACROSS THE SEA

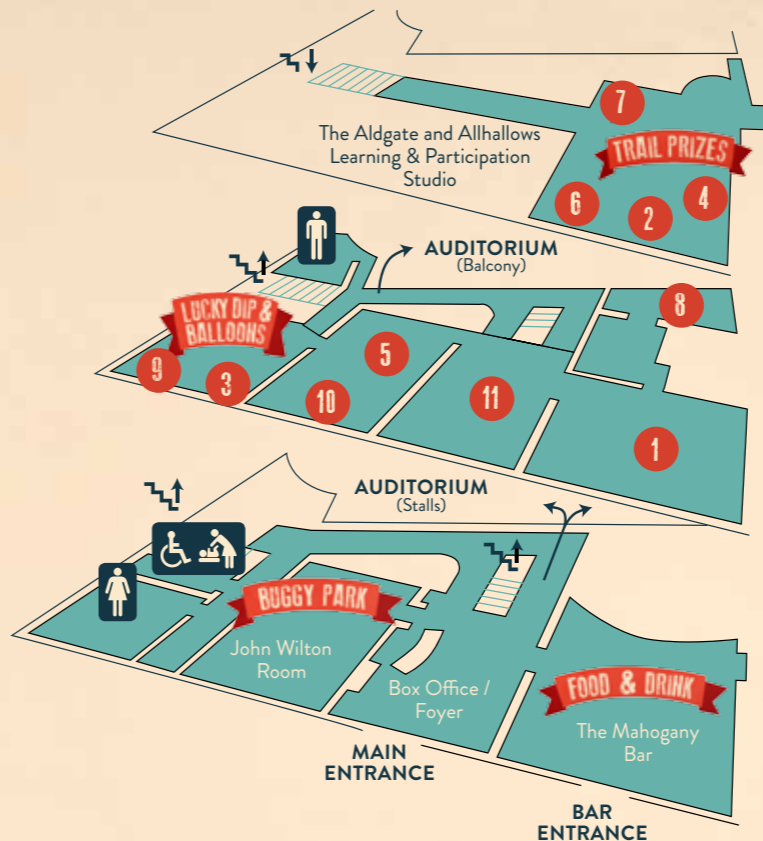
*Museum of London Docklands (Saturday Only)*
